Onsite registration for those not pre-registered will be at 7:30am outside of the Stars At Night Ballroom. Onsite registration fee will be \$15 per student.

Orientation for all students will begin at 8am in the Stars at Night Ballroom. At this time, students will receive a schedule for the Student Day and a leadership notebook which will include a Certificate of Attendance.

Activities for students from 8am until 5:00pm include Leadership Training with Frank Troyka and staff, special sessions with Dr. Tim Lautzenheiser and Fran Kick, TMEA or ATSSB All State Etude Presentation, and a college fair for students to visit with representatives from several Texas University Music Programs.
